Addendum

1.1. This document provides a list of responses that have been received in response to the 2015 monitoring and evaluation exercise. This information will serve to inform the Fifth Global Review of Aid for Trade that will take place on 30 June – 2 July 2015.

1.2. An analysis of these responses will be included in the publication "Aid for Trade at a Glance 2015: Reducing Trade Costs for Inclusive, Sustainable Growth" which will be presented at the Fifth Global Review of Aid for Trade.

1.3. A total number of 111 completed self-assessment questionnaires have been received: 62 from partner countries (including 30 least developed countries), ten from regional economic communities/transport corridors, 36 from donors (including international governmental organizations), and three from South-South partners. In addition, 116 case stories have also been submitted.

1.4. A list of respondents to the self-assessment questionnaire is provided in Annex 1. This list compares those responses received from delegations for the 2013 monitoring and evaluation exercise. A list of case story submissions is provided in Annex 2 (listed in the original language of submission).
