■ Objectives

The meeting has the following objectives:

- to discuss, with a view to adoption, the Istanbul Anti-Corruption Action Plan Fourth Round Monitoring reports on **Armenia, Kyrgyzstan** and **Ukraine** (sector evaluation) and progress reports on **Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan, Georgia, Mongolia, Tajikistan, Ukraine** and **Uzbekistan**;
- to launch the ACN thematic studies on Prevention of Corruption at Local Level, Confiscation and Independence of Prosecutors;
- to discuss the amendments to the IAP monitoring methodology, moving forward to the 5th round of monitoring: scope and procedures;
- to discuss progress on implementing the fundraising strategy and the signature of the MOU between the ACN members and the OECD;
- to discuss the implementation of the ACN Work Programme in 2018 and the future Work Programme.
