**ADB OECD Anti-Corruption Action Plan for Asia-Pacific (Action Plan)**

On behalf of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) Government, I am writing to convey the decision of the Government to endorse the above Action Plan in the capacity of Hong Kong, China.

The Government of the HKSAR attaches great importance to preventing and combating corruption. Legislation and policy are well-developed in the HKSAR in fighting corruption. We set up the Independent Commission Against Corruption, an independent statutory agency that reports directly to the Chief Executive of the HKSAR, in 1974 to combat corruption with a three-pronged strategy of investigation, prevention and education. We applaud the resolve of participating Governments in furthering this aim and support the principles and standards towards policy reform envisioned in the Action Plan. We also recognize the importance of political commitment and international efforts in the eradication of corruption. We look forward to co-operating and sharing our experience in fighting corruption with the international community through participating in the Action Plan.


