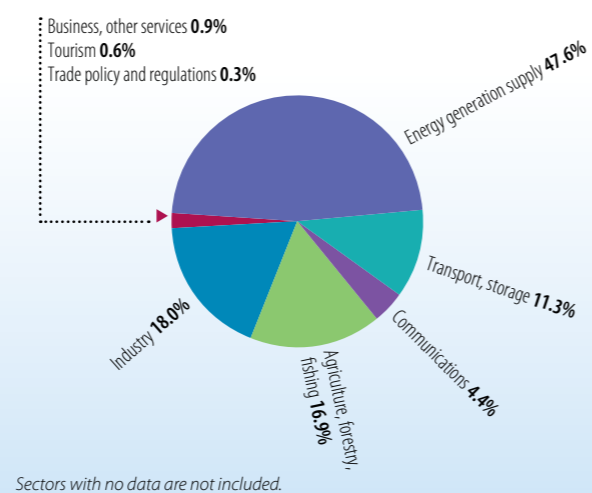

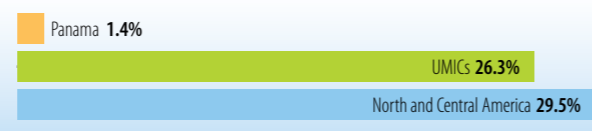

BY SECTOR (Share in total AFT, commitments, 2009)




SHARE IN ODA (Commitments, 2008-09 avg.)

AFT share in sector allocable ODA compared to its region and income group shares



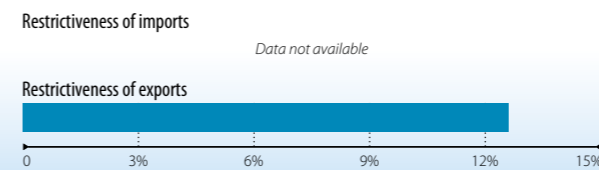

TRADE MAINSTREAMING¹⁴

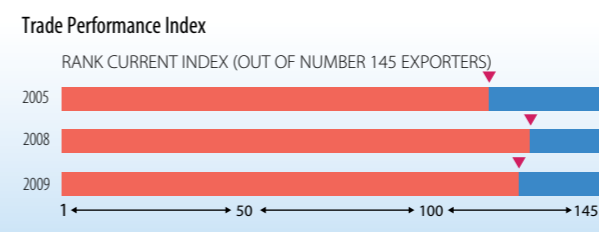
Aid-for-trade priorities remain unchanged.

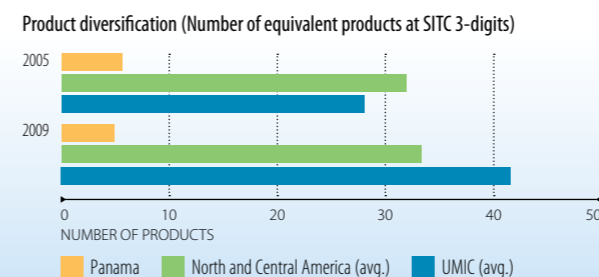

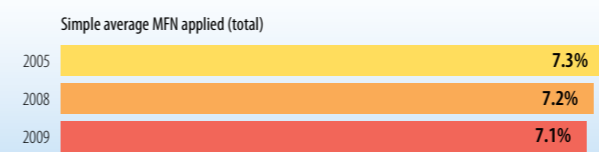
PRIORITY 1: COMPETITIVENESS¹⁶



PRIORITY 2: EXPORT DIVERSIFICATION¹⁷



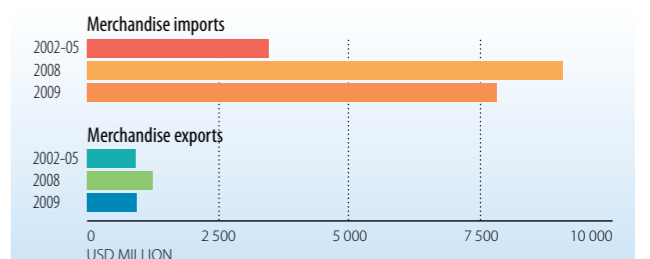

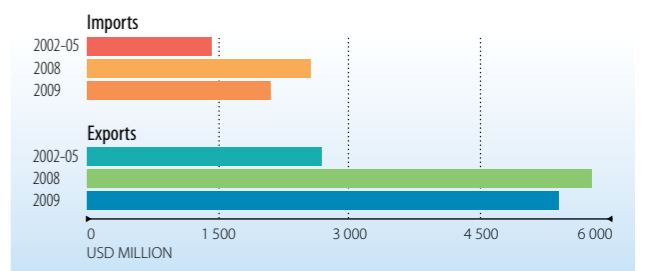

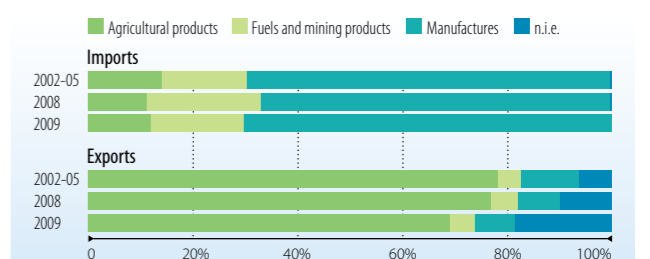
