Financing Country Evaluations

Procurement of country evaluation teams should follow national rules and regulations.

The Indicative budget for a country evaluation is €80.000 or \$120.000. Concurrent with developing the country specific Terms of Reference an eye should be kept on cost implications.

Funding for the country evaluations may be obtained from different sources:

Countries may finance the country evaluation from own sources or raise funds from donors in country. This is the preferred option as already existing systems can be used. The following countries have secured full funding from local sources: *Cambodia, Samoa, South Africa, Sri Lanka and Zambia*.

The following country evaluations will be financed from the Core Fund held by the PDE Secretariat at DIIS. Individual funding agreements will be negotiated between DIIS and the country: *Cameroon, Cook Islands, Indonesia, Malawi, Mali, and Vietnam.*

Some countries have secured partial funding which will be supplemented by donor Core Fund funding: *Colombia (Self/US/Spain)*, *the Philippines (Self/Core Fund)*.

Several donors have pledged direct funding for one or more country evaluations. In these cases funding arrangements will be negotiated between the donor and the country.

The following country evaluations will be financed by direct contributions from a donor:
