Who? Where? When?

- A **political** event that attracts ministerial attendance, with decisive outcomes
- **Busan**, Bexco. Host: Government of **Korea**
- This time next year: 29 November to 1 December 2011.



A 4th HLF to do what?

- **Stocktaking** from the Paris / Accra process
- Agreeing on features of **high quality aid** and its monitoring framework towards 2015
- Situating aid in its **broader development context**
 - More actors
 - Diversified approach: MICs, LICs, FS, regions
 - Linked topics: trade, security, climate...

Stocktaking of progress - Presentation of findings to HLF4

Key Messages and Recommendations

A single high-level publication targeting a political audience and drawing on monitoring and evaluation

Challenges in documenting progress

- **Prioritisation** of issues: progress on PD/AAA commitments drawing on survey and other sources of evidence
- Focus on **achievements** and behaviour change
- Need for **robust** and credible sources of evidence
- **Accessible language** to support messaging for non-specialist audience
- **Timely finalisation** to inform HLF4 outcome document

Busan HLF4 - Important considerations

- **MDG target date 2015** – only four years left
- Emphasise **existing commitments** – progress on Paris Declaration targets (drawing on both quantitative and qualitative evidence)
- Increase focus on **country level** implementation
- **Enhance inclusiveness** – CSOs, Parliaments, private sector, providers of SSC
- Maximise the **catalytic contribution of aid** - relevant principles based on evidence
- Maintain the **political momentum** in favour of aid (value for money, accountability for results...)

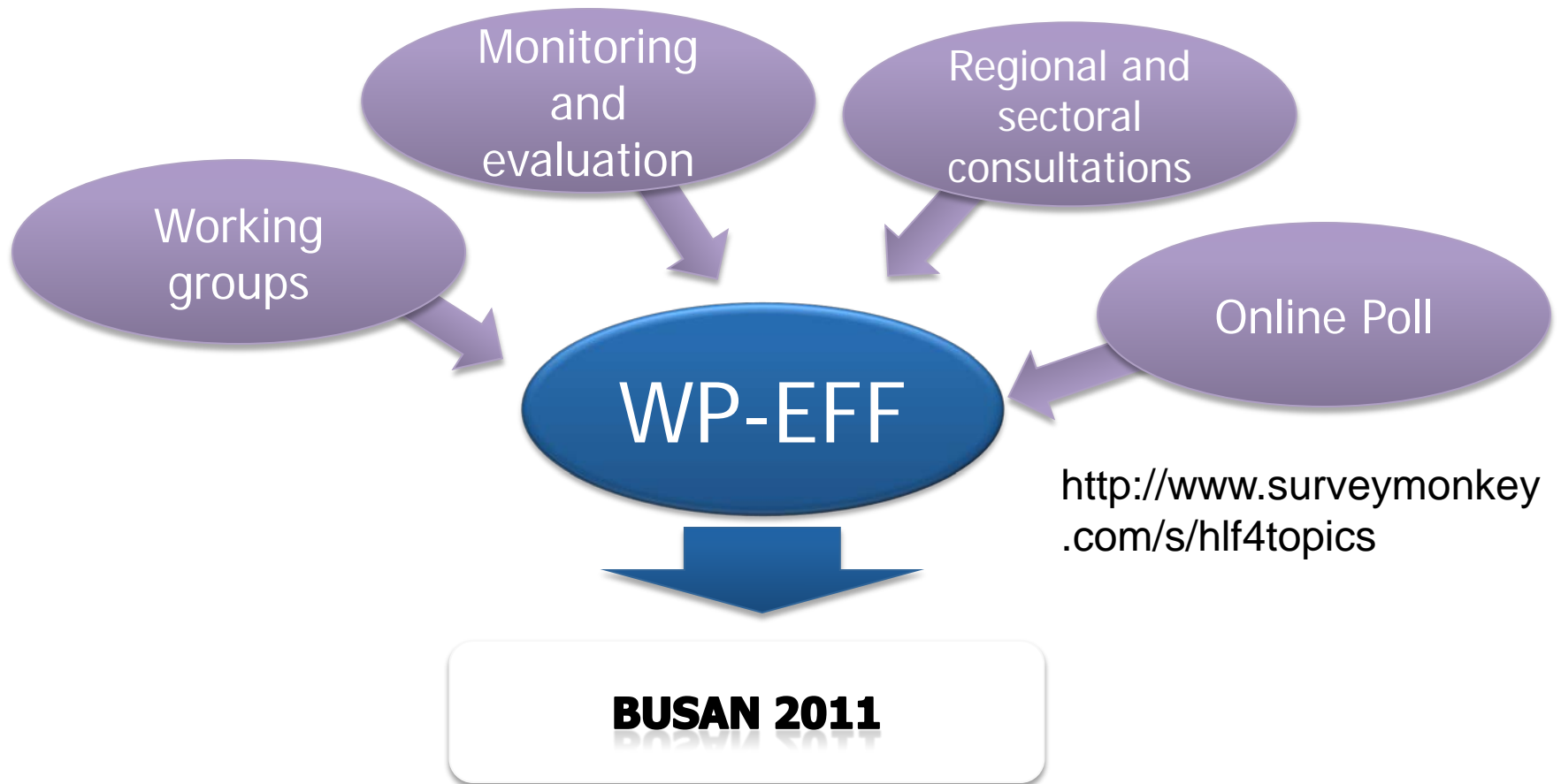
Format and Approach for HLF-4

- **Format**
 - Plenary sessions

 - ... to complete the Busan Outcome Document.
- **To be decided (by mid 2011):**
 - Type of outcome document
 - Main themes (early discussion on emerging themes through regional consultations)
- **Process**
 - Multi-stakeholder, open and transparent
 - Evidence-based inputs on what really matters (drawing on monitoring and evaluation)

- Regional **survey launch** workshops
(October-December 2010)
- **Online poll** (October – December 2010)
- Regional **Platforms** - e.g. CDDE, OAS, NEPAD/AfDB
- Ongoing consultations with **civil society**
(Better Aid – Open Forum)
- Other opportunities throughout 2011 (e.g regional meetings and high-level political events to be identified)

- Use of country systems,
- Division of labour,
- Predictability and
- Capacity development.

Timeline

- **Jan 2011** First deadline for submission of proposed themes
- **Mar 2011** Decision on a pre-list of themes for showcasing sessions & attribution of responsibilities
- **Jul-Oct 2011** Negotiation of the outcome document, and decision on themes for political debate & attribution of responsibilities
