problem analysis

the Lusaka Declaration enlarges the role of the ICGLR Secretariat

in addition to coordinating and facilitating political processes, it now also is expected to **guide and oversee the implementation** of the RINR

- making human and financial resources operational for the advisory and coordinating tasks of the CS
- ensure monitoring of the RINR implementation and feedback to Member States
- strengthen coordination of donor support and assure better linkage to international initiatives and processes



point of departure

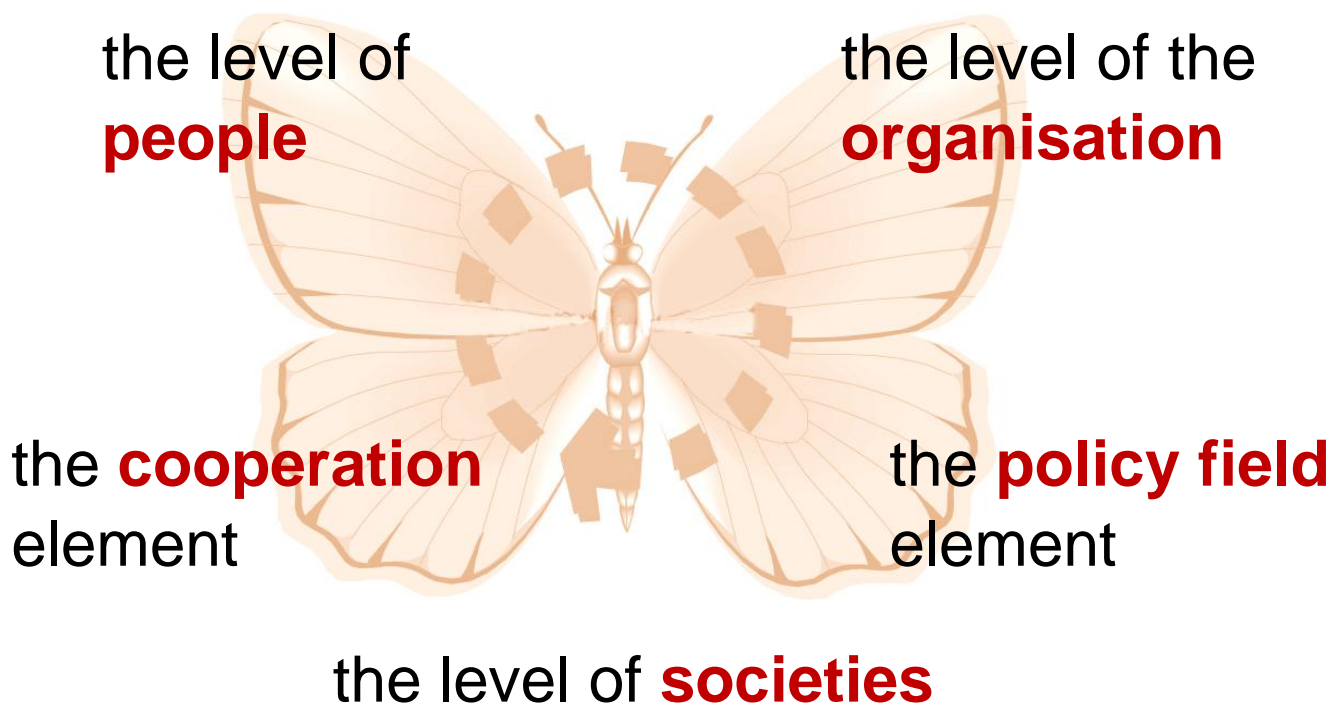
overall objective of the German support:

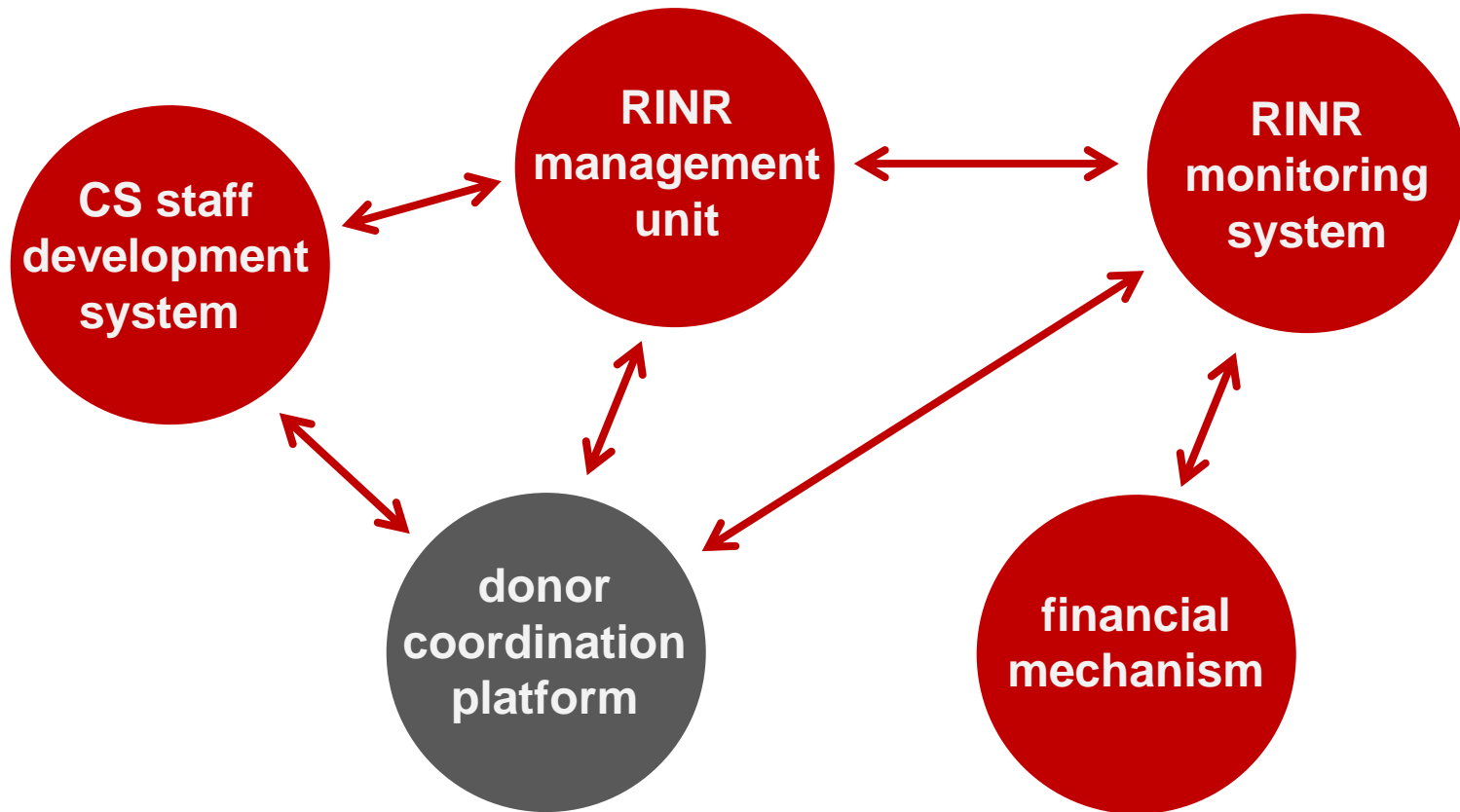

background and challenges

objectives

harmonisation of interventions in line with the RINR and its implementation in the ICGLR Member States.

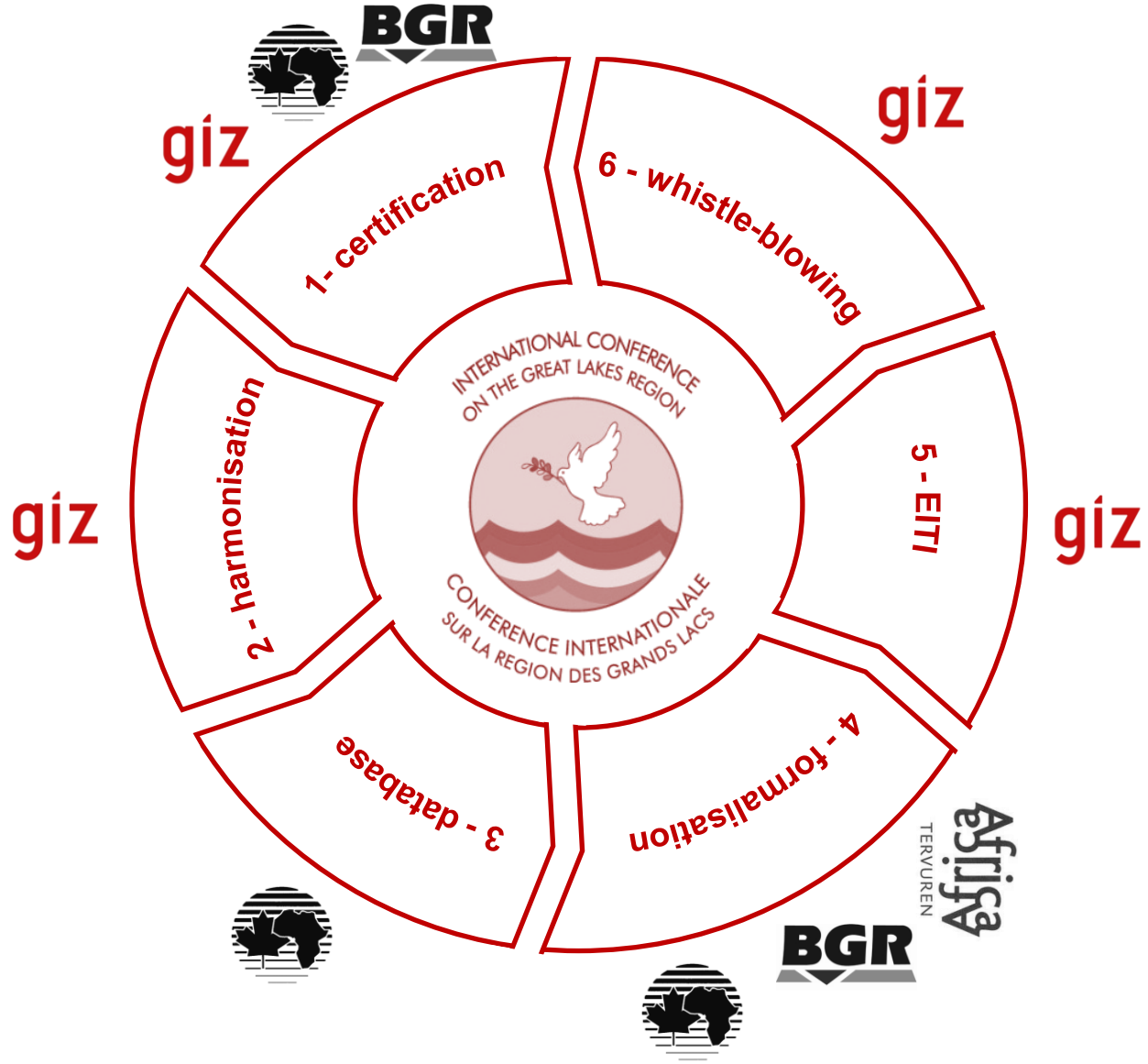
ensure coordination and follow up of support measures:

- **structured framework** for information sharing
- identify **synergies**, **joint activities** or **risks of duplication**
- discuss potential difficulties and come up with **joint solutions**



objectives (continued)

- ensure **alignment of partners' interventions on strategic orientations and priorities** of the Conference Secretariat and its Member States
- assess the **possibilities for interventions of new actors** to provide support to the RINR and its implementation in the ICGLR Member States





RINR as a learning field

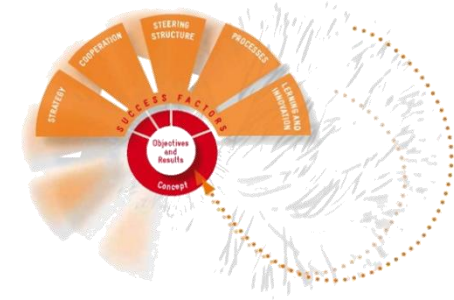
strategy: narrowed focus on a defined issue that is significant to the overall objective of the ICGLR

cooperation: establish ICGLR as key stakeholder, create international dimension, incorporate wide range of stakeholders, build on existing initiatives

steering structure: establish a formal platform between all MS, ensure regularity of meetings

processes: combine political process with technical approach

learning and innovation: scale-up from pilots, role-out to other initiatives
