


# Brief Introduction to Consultative Group to Assist the Poor (CGAP)

A global resource for microfinance with 34 members (donors and investors), established in 1995. Housed at the World Bank, but independent board and structure.






#### **CGAP's Aid Effectiveness Work**






### SmartAid: Underlying Rationale – Causal Chain






# But Performance & Use as Communicatins Tool is Mixed

|        | Points          | Range                 | Number of<br>Funders |
|--------|-----------------|-----------------------|----------------------|
| ****   | 90–100<br>80–89 | Very Good             | 0                    |
| ****   | 70–79<br>60–69  | Good                  | 4                    |
| *****  | 50–59<br>40–49  | Partially<br>Adequate | 4                    |
| ****** | 30–39<br>20–29  | Weak                  | 2                    |
| ****   | 10–19<br>0–9    | Inadequate            | 0                    |
