

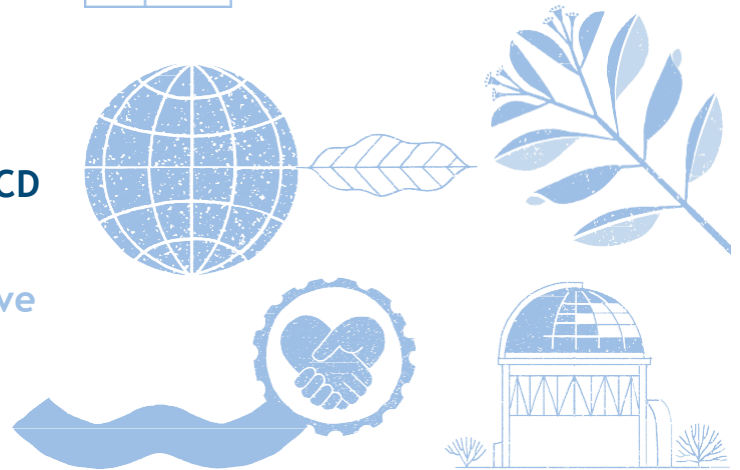

2023 ANNUAL CONFERENCE OF THE OECD GLOBAL FORUM ON PRODUCTIVITY

New policies for a sustainable productive
development and growth

27 - 28 September 2023 Santiago, Chile



1. About the conference

Led for the first time from Chile, the Annual Conference of the [OECD Global Forum on Productivity](#) will take place on 27-28 September 2023 in Santiago.

The event will bring together high-level officials from national and international organisations, top academics and experts on productivity and members of civil and business society, to discuss the best practices and the main findings of cutting-edge research on policies that impact productivity.

2. Purpose of this document

The purpose of this document is to provide attendees with useful information to facilitate their participation in the Conference and their visit to Chile.

The coordinators of the event will be at your disposal to answer any questions about logistics and organisation that you wish to formulate before the Conference and during its development.

3. Venue

The official sessions will take place in the O'Higgins Room (second floor) at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and the parallel meetings will take place in other dependencies of this building, located at Teatinos 180, Santiago, Región Metropolitana.

Although the building does not offer secured parking, delegations can conveniently be dropped off and picked up right in front of the premises. For those utilizing public transportation, the closest subway station is "La Moneda" (Line 1), a mere 5-minute walk from the building.

No conference fees will be charged.

6. Registration

After your enrollment, the registration system will send you an automatic note confirming receipt. Subsequently, once your registration request has been approved, you will receive a new "acceptance confirmation" email, which you must present along with your identification document when you pick up your badges.

Participants are invited to pick-up their badges at the on-site registration desk located at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (Teatinos 180, Santiago, Región Metropolitana) from Tuesday, September 26th at 5 p.m. until Thursday September 28th at 12 p.m. To do so, participants are requested to show a valid passport or national identity number if you are from Chile.

During the Conference, participants must carry their badge in a visible place. For security reasons, its use will be required to attend all sessions.

It is recommended for participants to arrive early, with a minimum of 30 minutes in advance, to ensure ample time for building access and security procedures before the morning's first panel starts. 7. Remote Participation

If on-site attendance is not possible, the organising team will provide the opportunity to attend the event online.

Registered participants will receive a confirmation email upon completing the registration form. Access links to follow the event remotely will be sent to registrants 72h ahead of the scheduled start.

8. Interpretation, Photos & Video Recordings

All meetings will be conducted in Spanish and English. Interpretation services will be provided. Pictures and videos will be taken during the event by the organisers, including a recording online. Participation in this conference will be considered acceptance of the use of these media during and after the event.
