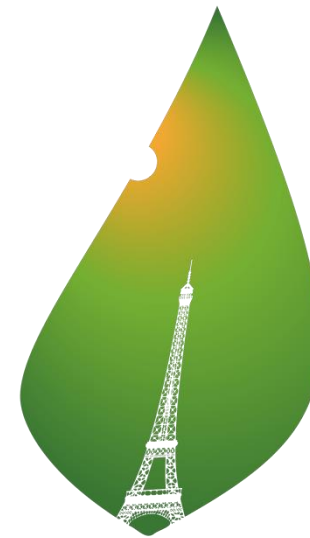

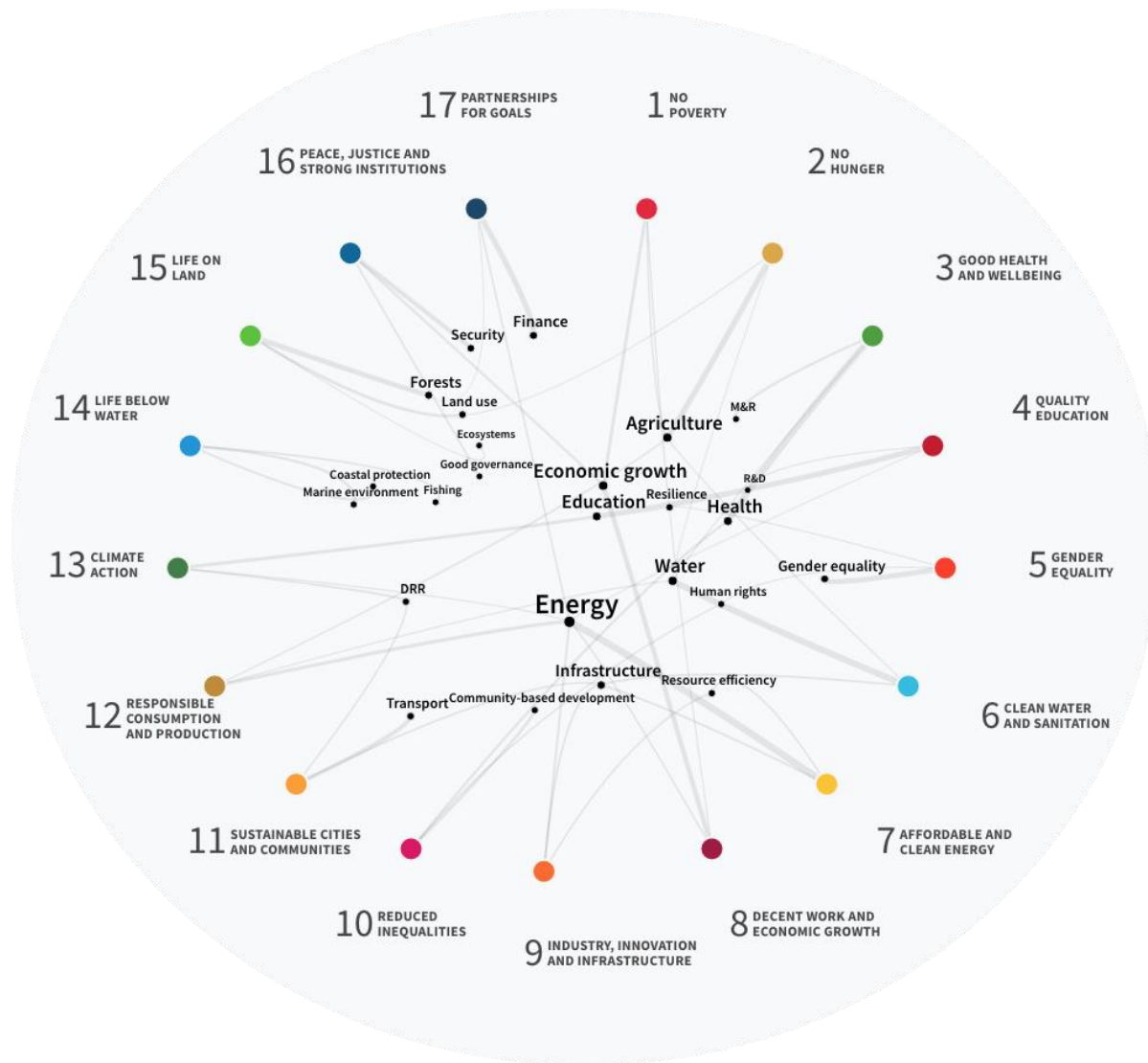

Connecting climate action to the Sustainable Development Goals





Systematic coding of the SDG governance mechanisms as described in VNRs 2016 – 2017 based on a **three-dimensional typology:**

- 1) Horizontal Coordination
- 2) Vertical Integration
- 3) Societal Inclusion

Identifying factors that shape institutional design choices



In a second step, coded data on types of SDG-governance mechanisms will be matched with data on political and administrative characteristics of countries (e.g. regime type, state capacity, form of state organization, state fragility etc.)

Learning how countries' political dynamics and characteristics of their political and administrative system relate to their SDG-governance mechanisms will help us to

- identify root causes of reform blockades as well as enablers for institutional reforms
- Identify entry points for inter- and transnational support to integrated SDG implementation
- cluster and systematize reform options for different countries, thereby making policy advice more efficient
