Description

Increasing information on available contract opportunities

The Crown Commercial Service in the United Kingdom is responsible for managing the procurement of common goods and services for over 17 000 customer organisations in the public sector, and their services are provided by more than 5 000 suppliers. To increase information on available low-value contract opportunities, the website <u>Contracts</u> <u>Finder was developed</u>.

This website makes it possible for suppliers to search for information about contracts worth over GBP 10 000 with the government and its agencies. Suppliers can use Contracts Finder to:

- search for contract opportunities in different sectors
- · find out what is coming up in the future
- look up details of previous tenders and contracts. Suppliers can create an account to get email updates and save their searches.
