Mr. Meade holds a Ph.D. in economics from the University of Yale, a bachelor's degree in law from the Law Faculty of the National University of Mexico (UNAM), and a degree in economics with honors from the *Instituto Tecnológico Autónomo de México* (ITAM).

He began his professional career at the National Insurance and Finance Commission and has held several positions in the Public Administration within the financial sector, including General Director of Financial Planning of the National Commission on the Savings System for Retirement (CONSAR), Assistant Secretary of Savings Protection, the Institute for the Protection of Bank Savings (IPAB), Director General of Banking and Savings of the Department of Finance and Public Credit (SHCP) and Director General of the National Bank of Rural Credit (BANRURAL). Under the previous Administration, he served as Director-General of the Rural Development Bank (*Financiera Rural*).

He currently serves as State Secretary of Revenue in the Ministry of Finance.

Born on February 27th, 1969, Mr. Meade has been a professor of economics at ITAM, and published several articles on microeconomics and the economic analysis of law.
