

Mr. Luiz Eduardo Melin Chief of Staff

Mr. Melin is the Chief of Staff of the Brazilian Minister of Finance. He has a PhD in International Economy by the University of Essex, England. He also holds a Master's degree in Law and International Relations and a B.A. in Economy by PUC University in Rio de Janeiro. Mr. Melin is a permanent staff of the Brazilian Central Bank and Effective Professor of the PUC University in Rio de Janeiro.

He worked in the international area at the Lloyds Bank, commanded the Economic Advisory of the National Association of the Private Insurance and Capitalization Companies (Fenaseg) and he was an invited teacher of the Centre de Recherche Politique de la Sorbonne – CRPS, in France.

At the Central Bank and later at the BNDES (Brazilian Development Bank), where Mr. Melin worked as Director of International Affairs, he has large experience in integrating and heading different missions abroad of various purposes, from technical interchange and cooperation agreements to negotiations of financial and foreign trade matters, both with foreign governments (Japan, Argentina, China, Canada, Venezuela, Russia, among others) and international organisms (OECD, Mercosul, BIS, IADB, CAF).
