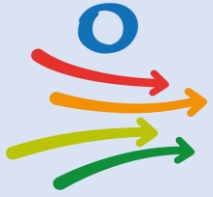

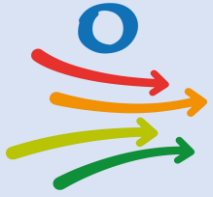
# UN Development Account Project on Migration Statistics

## **Objectives**

- To strengthen national capacities in collecting and compiling internationally comparable migration data that meet international standards;
- To enhance understanding of the uses and limitations of migration data for policy purposes and for the monitoring of the migration related goals and targets in the 2030 Development Agenda.

## **Period**

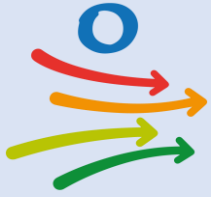
- January 2018 to December 2021 (four years)

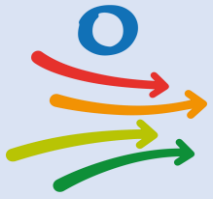
## Implementation

  - IOM

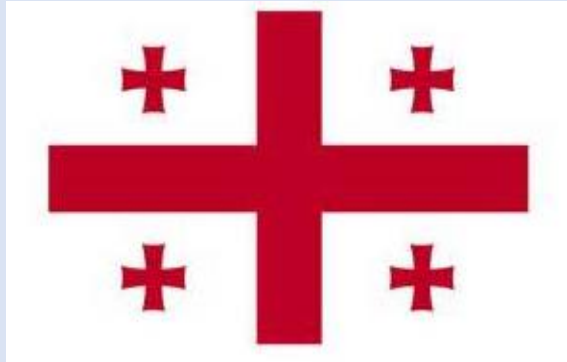


## Main Activities

1. Production of Methodological Guidelines for the production of migration-related SDG Indicators
2. Regional Workshops in Asia and Latin America (by ESCAP, ECLAC)
3. National Workshops in six focus countries, tailored to the needs of respective country
4. MSE studies in four pilot countries (by UNODC)
5. Production of e-Learning materials on the production of migration-related SDG indicators
6. Collection of official migration statistics
7. Launch of a global interactive data portal on migration statistics

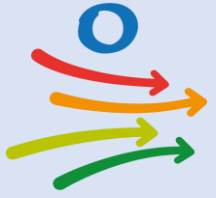
