Strategic aims of the DIS/MIS Resource Hub

Strengthen information integrity and reinforce democracy



Governance architecture and initiatives

- Whole-of-government coordination, strategies and training; evaluation of responses; strategic communications, crisis management and counteracting foreign interference
- Initiatives to engage with external partners – including international organisations – to track and respond to disinformation

Strengthening societal resilience

- Whole-of-society focus, including media and digital literacy; structures to engage with civil society and academia; communicating with and engaging across society; promoting diverse and independent media

Regulatory and policy responses

- Build understanding around the values and objectives of regulation; map relevant regulatory entry points
