

- 1. We had no information on out of school
- 2. Build capacities to develop processes with the population outside the educational system.
- 3. The possibility of having indicators focused on the completion of compulsory education.
- 4. Know the existing skills in the population that is out of school
- 5. Provide information that allows decision-making.




Analysis of data and preparation of national report

- Participation in PISA-D Lead Analysts
 Programme from April to September 2018
- Preparation and launch of National Report on in-school assessment (Strands A and B) in December 2018
- Analysis of Strand C data and preparation of updated national report incorporating analysis of data from Strands A, B and C
- Final national report launched on 1st
 December 2020
