## PISA-D out-of-school assessment next steps: three options


1. A *stand-alone* international option as part of a future PISA cycle – for experienced PISA participants with low rate of coverage

2. An international option as part of a future PISA cycle *linked* to a household survey – for experienced PISA participants with low rate of coverage
