Timothy R. Wojan is currently a Senior Economist in the Rural Economy Branch, Resource and Rural Economics Division, US Department of Agriculture. Tim led development of the 2014 Rural Establishment Innovation Survey that provides a new window on innovation processes within rural firms and the local contextual factors associated with innovation. He has also produced seminal research on the intersection of innovation, the arts, and economic dynamism in rural areas that has been published in the *Journal of Economic Geography* and *PLoS ONE*. Other research assesses place-based alternatives to rural and agricultural development policy, investigates improvement in innovation indicators, and develops innovative protocols for statistical testing required by the new emphasis on evidence-based policymaking. Tim has a Ph.D. in Agricultural and Applied Economics from the University of Wisconsin and a B.A. from Oberlin College.
