

# **UNIA** and cooperation


- UNIA, which can be considered as an example of interuniversity cooperation, is governed by a Board of Trustees made up of all the other Andalusian Rectors





  - Reinforce the co-operation in training by means of our grants policies



# Aimed to develop cooperation academic projects among La Rabida Group universities. Focused on University departments or Research groups. Six economic aids are yearly offered, up to 5.000 € each, to encourage scientific collaboration programmes with teaching staff mobility. Two years period, and one year renewal if required, subject to: Coordinated elaboration of a 60 h. academic module on a priority area Effective teaching of the module in two Latin-American universities.
