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
## Corrigendum

Page 89, Figure 5.11. Remuneration of doctors, ratio to average wage, 2013 (or nearest year)

Data on the remuneration of self-employed doctors in <u>France</u> exclude their social security contributions, thereby resulting in an underestimation of their gross income.

Page 101, Figure 6.2. Estimated number of consultations per doctor, 2013 (or nearest year)

Data for Ireland should be 1 450 (instead of 921). The reference year is 2010 (as 2010 is the latest available year for data on the number of consultations per doctor per person in Ireland).

## Page 127, Figure 7.9. Physician density, by Territorial Level 2 regions, 2013 (or nearest year)

<u>Data for Chile have been amended:</u> The data initially released were based on a national data source that was under-estimating the density of physicians across different regions in Chile. The revised data for Chile relate to 2009 (latest year available) and do not reflect the increase in the number of physicians since then (also leading to a certain degree of under-estimation, but less so than the previous source).
