The Steering Group meeting will focus on the review of the implementation of the **ACN 2016-2019 Work Programme** and the preparation of the **future Work Programme**.

ACN delegates are also invited to take part in the **OECD Global Forum on Anti-Corruption and Integrity** to learn about new trends, experiences and best practices from around the world.
