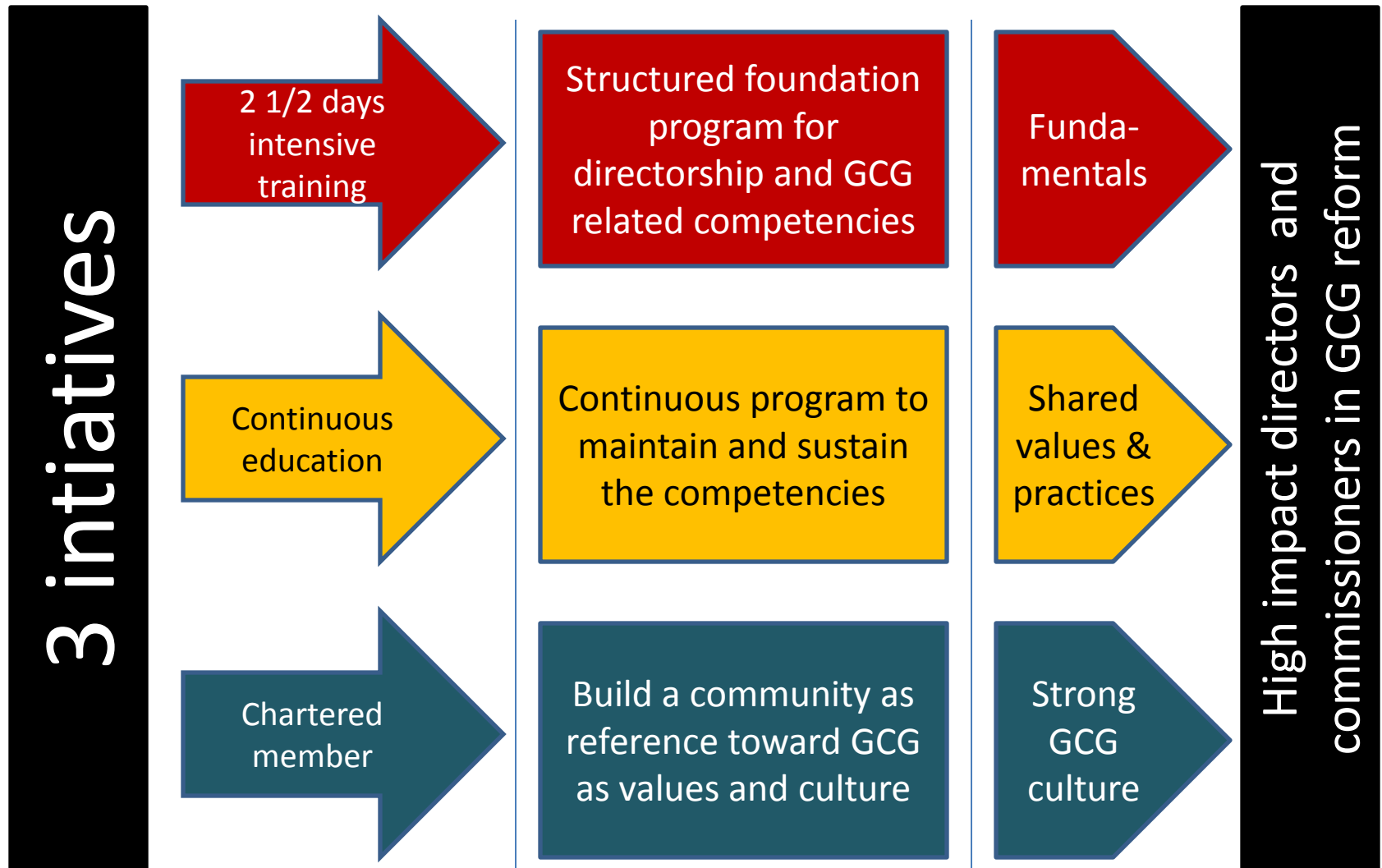
The Roles

NCG = National Committee on Governance

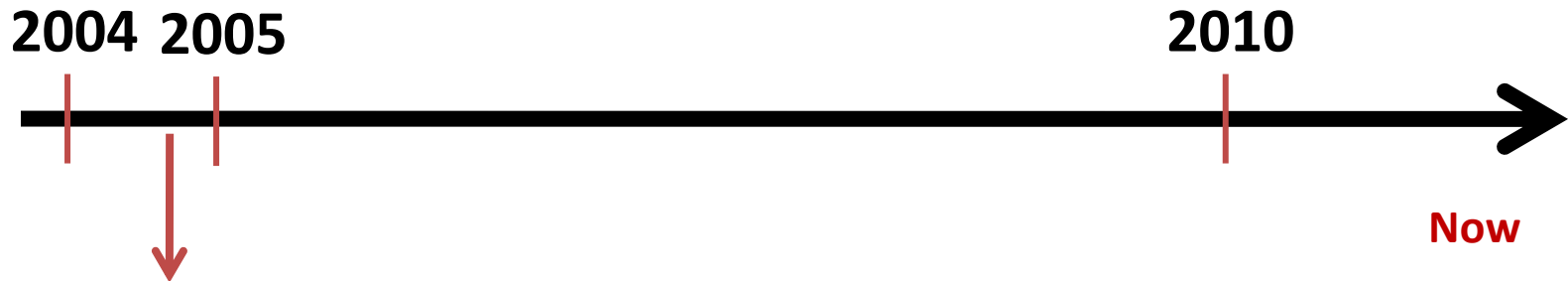
Directorship training program



2 1/2 days intensive training

- **Sharing of 'current issues' – by a minister level or equivalent**
- **GCG concepts, Principles and Practices**
- **Business ethics**
- **Enterprise Risk Management**
- **Boards' duties, Liabilities and Responsibilities**
- **High Quality Corporate Reporting**
- **Leading change**
- **Corporate Social Responsibility**
- **Stakeholder Management & Public Governance**

Progress to now



Start the directorship training program

- **21 batches of IP directorship training programs**
- **12 CPEs – half day program**
- **More 200 directors and commissioners**
- **More than 100 SOE directors and commissioners**
- **Almost 200 chartered members**

Challenges

- Most of participants coming from 'already high-level awareness of GCG' companies'.
- Not a mandatory 'yet' – in term of explicit requirements.
