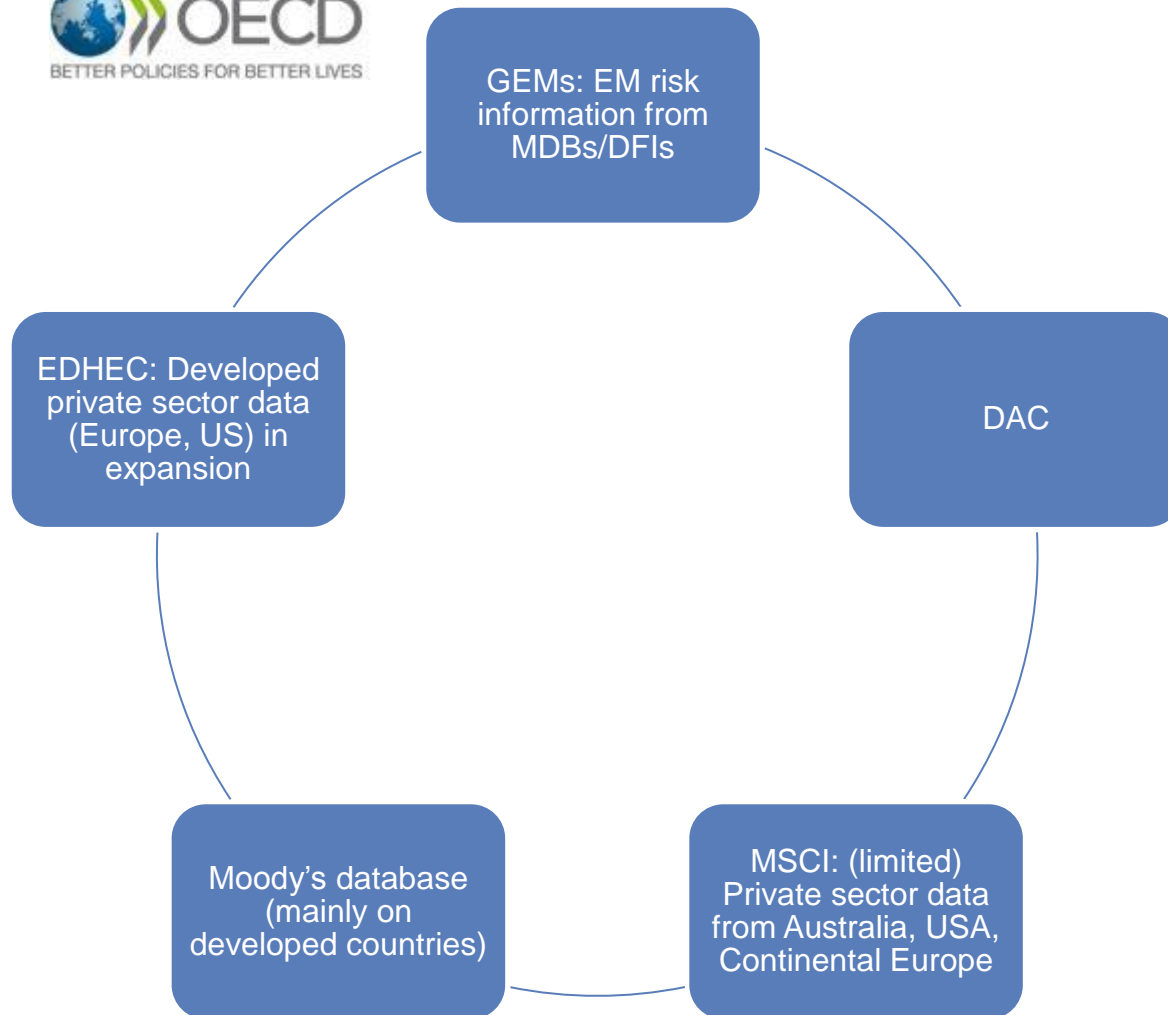
Infrastructure investors currently have limited data about actual long-term financial data on infrastructure projects, particularly in developing markets

# Proposed solution

Centralised repository on historical long-term actual data on infrastructure at an asset level, focussed on developing markets

Proper template

- **Investors** – provide prospective investors with information that will enable them to assess investment opportunities more accurately, particularly emerging markets
- **Financial Regulators** – provide more accurate information on the risk and return of infrastructure
- **Governments / infrastructure policy makers** – governments are better informed on the financial and non-financial performance and distribution (by regions, instruments, etc.) of projects to derive policy orientations.

# How it could be done

Collect data from IFIs/DFIs on financed projects

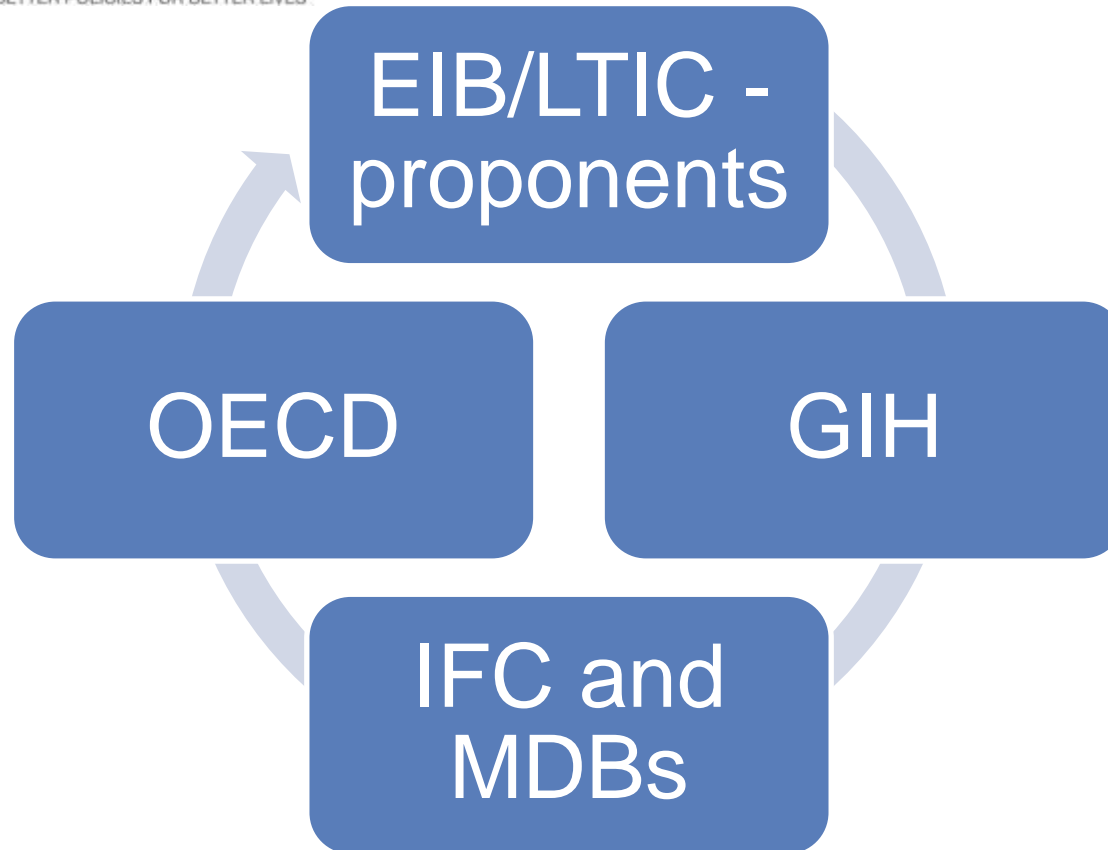
Collect information from Governments and local authorities directly from a central repository

Define a standard template to collect information leveraging on existing experiences

Provide direct access at a reasonable aggregate level to ensure respect of confidentiality agreements

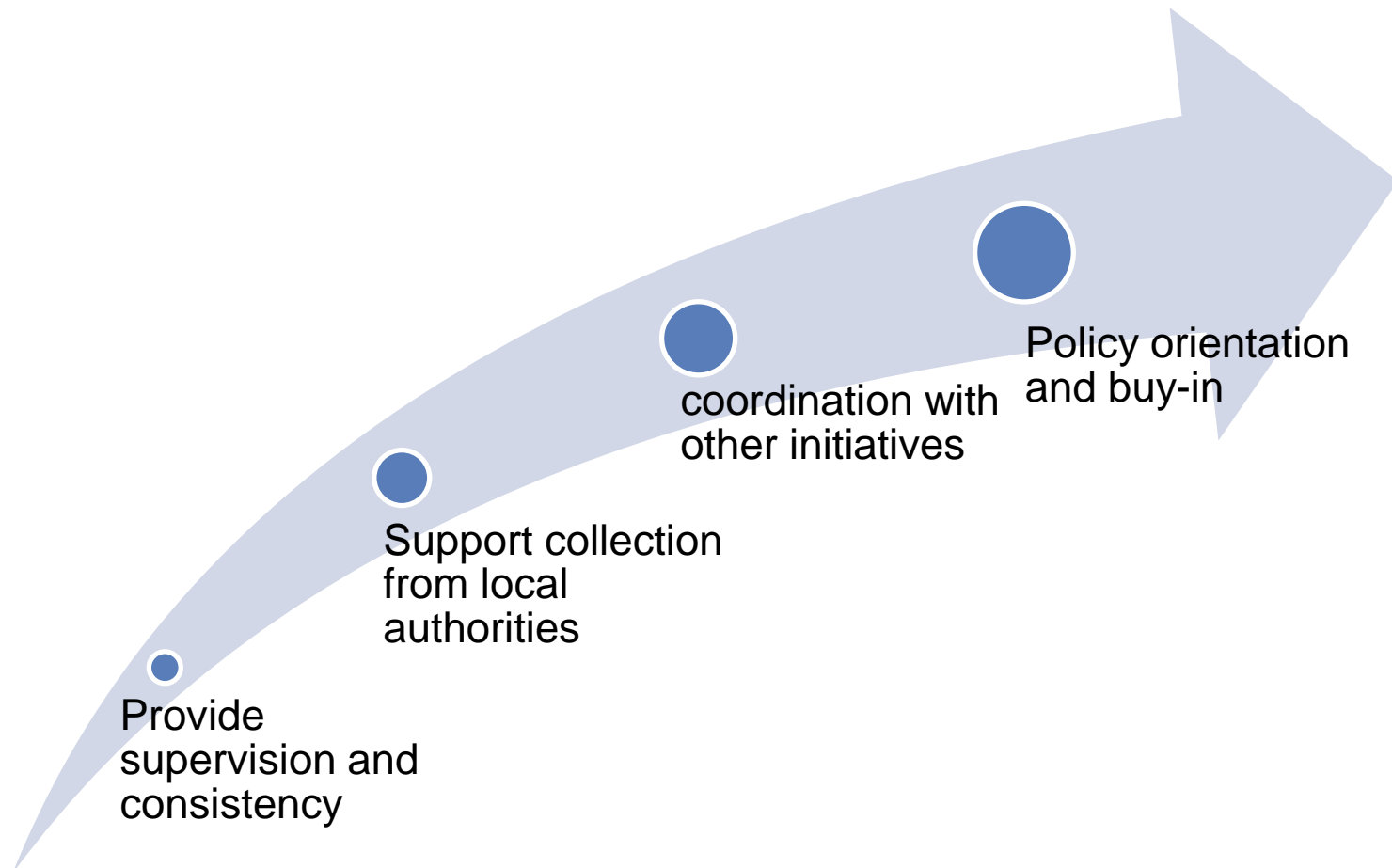
Consider cost cover solution
