




## INSTRUCTIONS FOR THOSE WHO ARE NEW TO MYOECD


1. Go to the main OECD webpage, at [www.oecd.org](http://www.oecd.org)



2. Click on 'MY OECD' at the top right of the screen



3. This will bring up a dialogue box, inviting you to either sign in or register. If you have never registered before, **click on 'register'**. If you are already using MyOECD, go to the bottom of this document for instructions.



4. You will now be presented with a registration form like the one below. Fill in your details in the top half of the form (compulsory fields are marked with an asterisk). In the 'define your profile' section, below your contact information, select the themes which interest you. If you include 'employment', 'international migration', 'social issues' or any combination of the three, you will be given the option on the next screen to receive email alerts on our "OECD Social, Employment and Migration Working Papers". Similarly, if you select 'Health', you will then be given the option to receive email alerts regarding our series "OECD Health Working Papers". You may, of course, register for both.
