USAID's Development Mission

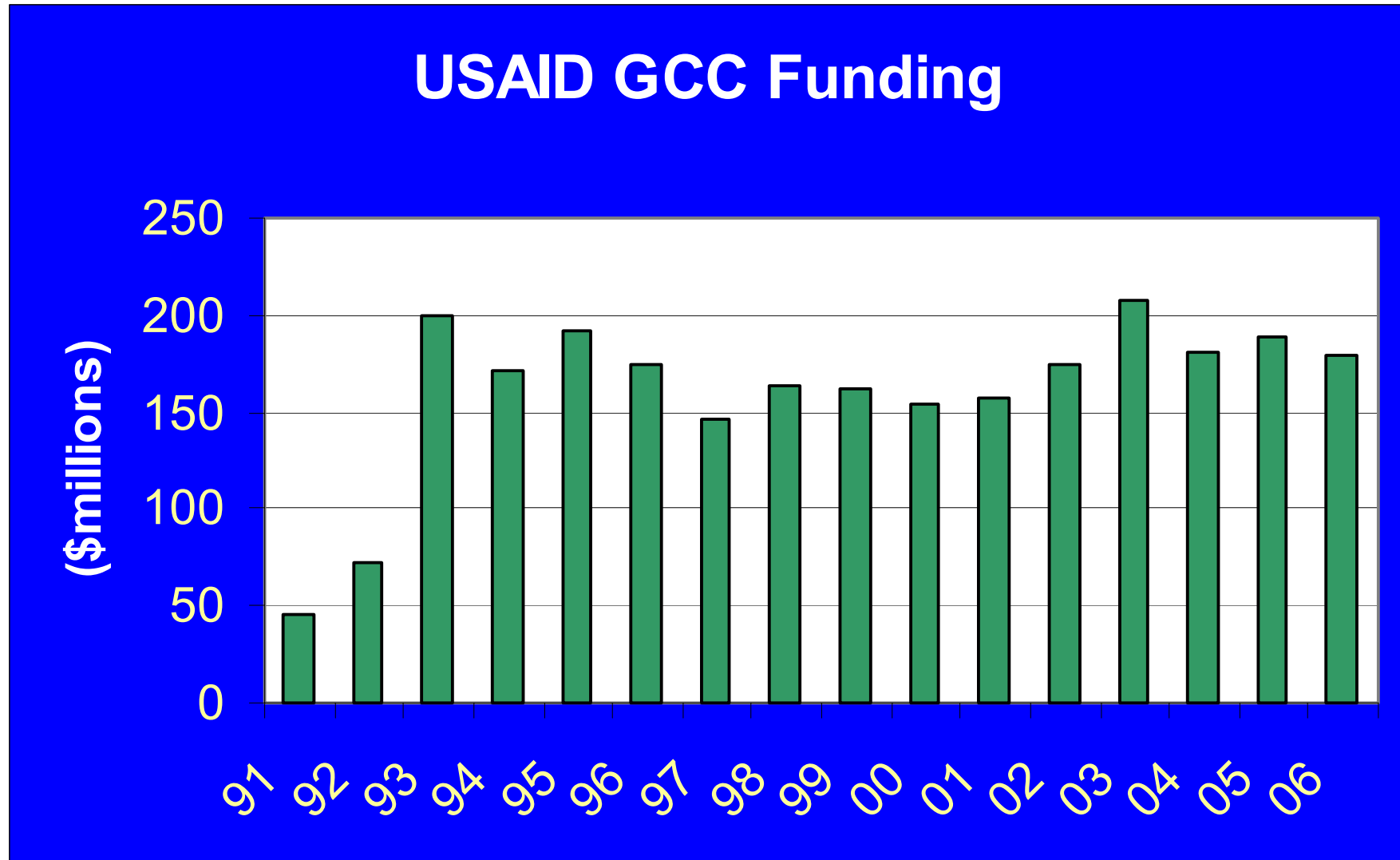
- Pressing needs: avian flu, AIDs, malaria, hunger, disaster response

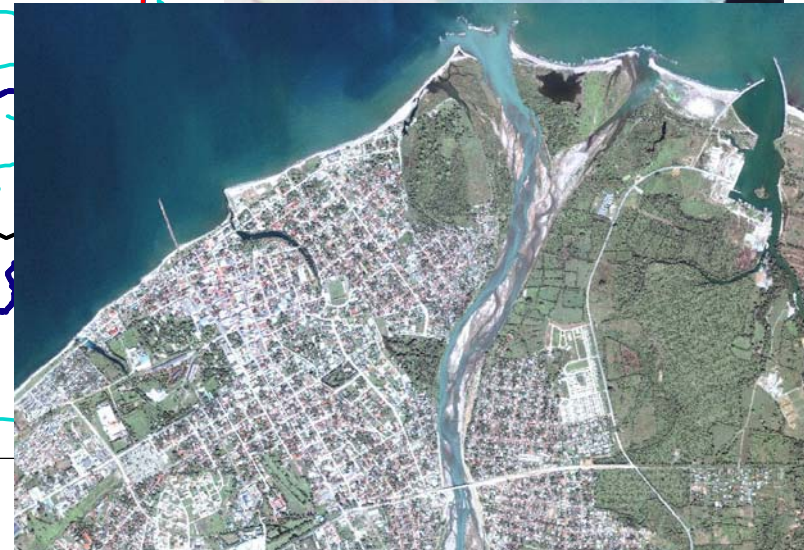
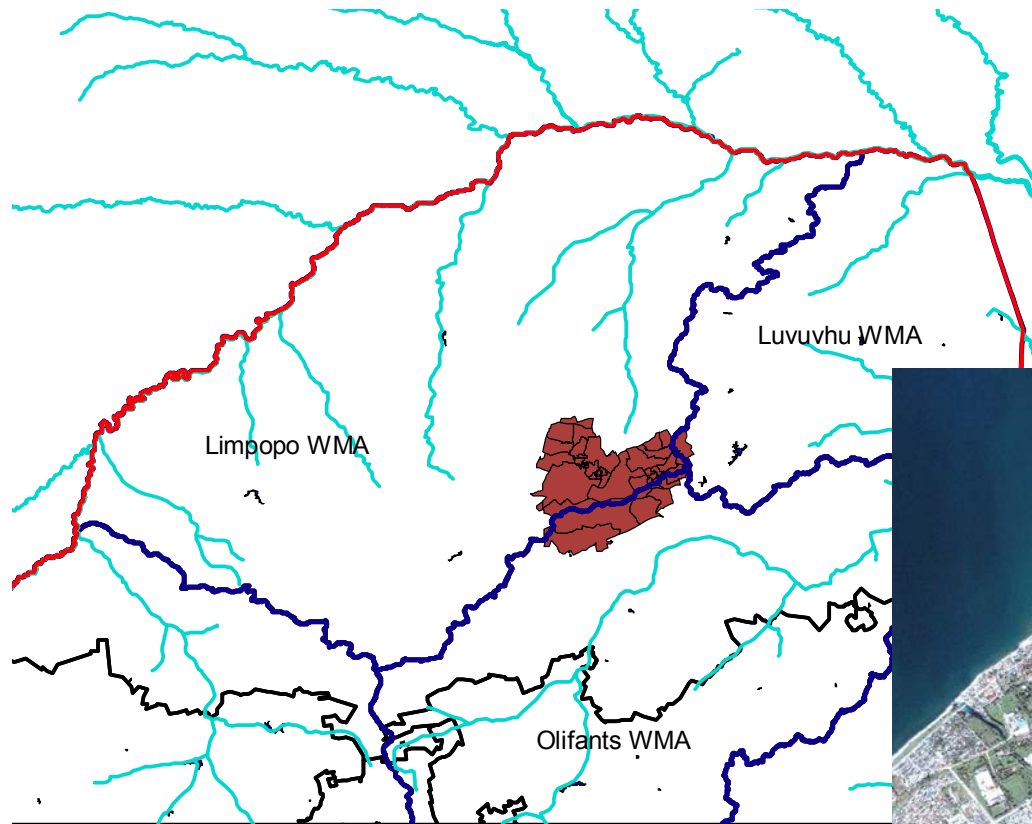
- Economic development contributes to resiliency to climate variability and change
