

Potential GST1 outputs on adaptation

Follow-up by Parties, UNFCCC processes & relevant bodies

✓ Invite Parties to conduct self-assessments of adaptation efforts in submissions to the UNFCCC, which could inform future GSTs Follow-up by non-Party stakeholders (NPS)


✓ Encourage research community to address priority gaps in information, guidance & Technical information for policy makers & practioners

 √ Identify priority adaptation-related information needs and gaps

- ✓ Invite AC-LEG-SCF to assess approaches to review adequacy & effectiveness of adaptation, and options for combining different approaches
- ✓ Invite PCCB to prioritise GST1 follow-up, incl. support to develop and enhance M&E/MEL systems
- methodologies
- ✓ Encourage NPS to incorporate GST1 findings in country support work, incl. to implement NAPs, to enhance M&E/MEL systems etc.
- ✓ Identify enabling factors and criteria for effective adaptation action
- √ Identify good practices, experiences and lessons learned
