



PROCEEDINGS AND OUTCOMES OF THE

10th Meeting of the Inter-ministerial Steering Committee of the National Policy Dialogue on Integrated Water Resources Management in Azerbaijan followed by Thematic Workshop on Nature Based Solutions

5-6 April 2023 Baku, Azerbaijan







1. Proceedings and Outcomes

1.1. The National Policy Dialogue

On the 5th of April 2023, the 10th Meeting of the Inter-ministerial Steering Committee of the National Policy Dialogue (NPD) on Integrated Water Resources Management engaged a broad representation from national and local authorities, academic and NGO communities. Chaired by the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources and organised with support from the European Union, the NPD meeting took stock of priorities for water management and the environment, reviewed progress with recent policy reforms in the water sector and briefed the steering committee members on the latest developments with ongoing national and international projects in Azerbaijan. It was followed by a workshop on Nature-based Solutions (NbS) on 6 April.

During the opening session, Deputy Minister Tagiyeva spoke about the importance of water issues in Azerbaijan, particularly in the context of population growth and climate change. Deputy Minister Tagiyeva also spoke about the recent United Nations Water Conference in New York in March 2023 and about Azerbaijan's and the EU's commitment to the Water Action Agenda.

Mr Peter Michalko, Ambassador of the European Union in Azerbaijan, also provided opening remarks, emphasising that the European Union is supporting Azerbaijan to achieve sustainable reforms in the water sector as part of the EU4Environment programme. He noted that the EU Economic and Investment Plan also plays a role in assisting Azerbaijan and other Eastern Partnership countries in transforming their economies and making them more resilient. However, he noted that this cannot be achieved without a clear water strategy, modern water management tools and stakeholder engagement.

Session 1 was a dialogue on water resources management in the framework of the "EU4Environment Water Resources and Environmental Data" Programme. The programme's implementing partners (the Environment Agency Austria (UBA), the Austrian Development Agency (ADA), the International Office for Water (OiEau), the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), and the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE)) presented programme progress in Azerbaijan in areas such as river basin planning, water monitoring, including wastewater-based epidemiological surveillance, transboundary cooperation, and economic instruments. The NPD participants engaged with comments and questions on programme implementation, and expressed satisfaction with progress on programme implementation.

Session 2, led by the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources, focussed on Azerbaijan's current situation regarding water use and protection. Government officials discussed Azerbaijan's draft water strategy, water use in agriculture and irrigation, and ongoing plans related to water use in other economic sectors, such as energy and recreation, as well as plans for water resources protection and sustainable management, including the establishment of the new State Water Resources Agency. In particular, Azerbaijan's draft water strategy was a strong point of discussion. The strategy has been under development for some years, with significant input received from international partners, in particular the now completed "EU Water Initiative Plus" Programme. Government representatives noted that there was an urgent need to finalise the water strategy, institutionalising Integrated Water Resources Management and River Basin Management Planning approaches.





Session 3 facilitated a dialogue on environmental statistics and open data. Progress made in the framework of the EU4Environment Water Resources and Environmental Data Programme was discussed, as was the need for more open access to data, enhancing international cooperation on data with the European Environment Agency, and pushing forward with data and progress on land and air quality data.

The NPD also had an important coordination role among international partners supporting Azerbaijan on water and environmental data-related issues. The breadth of projects discussed during Session 4 ranged from infrastructure to finance to awareness raising, underlining the importance and benefits of further enhancing communication between both the different actors and the government.

Key outcomes of the discussions included:

- A commitment from the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources to revise and finalize the water strategy within the next few months, ensuring that it enshrined good international practice, aligned with the EU Water Framework Directive and guiding principles of Integrated Water Resources Management. Implementing Partners confirmed their availability for any support still needed.
- Agreement to finalise delineation of basin districts and create an enabling environment for the enhanced application of the basin management approach through River Basin Management
- A call for an approach to sequencing tariff and policy changes that takes into account their impact on different sectors, to ensure that changes are well understood by stakeholders and can be adapted to.
- Support for further institutionalising the IWRM approach through the newly established State Water Resources Agency by enshrining IWRM in its principles. Implementing Partners are ready to provide required support to the new Agency.
- Agreement on the need for application of prioritized and equitable water allocation with due attention to ecosystem flow needs and environmental flows.
- Agreement that stakeholders in Azerbaijan must take into account the economic dimensions of water to ensure the benefits and costs of water management are properly evaluated.
- Support for furthering transboundary cooperation through, for example, increased and joint water monitoring and information sharing.
- A commitment to revisit the current approach and legal framework for management of water and environmental data, to make it more accessible to national stakeholders.
- Agreement that international organizations and projects should regularly coordinate and communicate their activities to maximise synergies in implementation.

Workshop and site visit on Nature-based Solutions

NbS is a relatively new concept in Azerbaijan and there was enthusiastic participation in the workshop, with diverse stakeholders represented. Opening remarks on the EU approach were provided by Karin Zaunberger of the European Commission's DG Environment via a video address and James Dalton of the International Union for the Conservation of Nature (IUCN) complimented with a scene-setting presentation about the broader context. These interventions spurred great interest from national participants about what qualified as an NbS, how they could be deployed, and how they could be financed. Across back-to-back sessions, existing projects in Azerbaijan were discussed, followed by a look at some examples from beyond its borders. What came out clearly in the discussion is that though the





concept is new, some of what is happening in Azerbaijan's water management sector already qualifies or is close to being nature-based.

As part of the NbS workshop, a site visit was made to Khojahasan Lake, near Baku. Mr Mukhtar Babayev, Minister of Ecology and Natural Resources of Azerbaijan, joined the site visit and invited participants to take part in a tree planting ceremony and an animated discussion about Azerbaijan's ambitious plans for environment and water sectors, the EU4Environment Water and Data Programme, the outcomes of the NPD, and the need to finalise the water strategy.





2. Participation and visibility

Across the 1.5 days over 76 participants joined the NPD and NbS workshop, almost entirely in person. Participants were 34% female and 66% male representing a very diverse list of public and private stakeholders.

Five different Azerbaijani media outlets published about the NPD meeting. A Twitter post by UNECE Water Convention and Protocol on Water and Health also made mention of the European Union. A news article was published on the website of the French-Azerbaijani University, which mentions the EU4Environment programme, and was later shared on the Facebook page of the programme, who had previously reported about the NPD.

About National Policy Dialogues

National Policy Dialogues facilitates policy discussions where stakeholders meet to advance water policy reforms. NPDs are driven by the demand from the host countries and are usually chaired by heads of respective government agencies. A variety of stakeholders participate in the meetings, such as ministries and government agencies and institutions, as well as nongovernmental organisations, the business community, parliamentary bodies, academia. Participants typically include international organisations and EU Member States active in water policy reforms in each country. Under the EU-funded EU4Environment Water Resources and Environmental Data Programme, NPDs are supported in the five Eastern Partnership countries.

About EU4Environment – Water Resources and Environmental Data

This programme aims at improving people's wellbeing in EU's Eastern Partner Countries and enabling their green transformation in line with the European Green Deal and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The programme's activities are clustered around two specific objectives:

1) support a more sustainable use of water resources and 2) improve the use of sound environmental data and their availability for policy-makers and citizens. The programme is implemented by five Partner organisations: Environment Agency Austria (UBA), Austrian Development Agency (ADA), International Office for Water (OiEau) (France), Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE). The programme is principally funded by the European Union and co-funded by the Austrian Development Cooperation and the French Artois-Picardie Water Agency based on a budget of EUR 12,75 million (EUR 12 million EU contribution). The implementation period is 2021-2024.
