Sound laws and regulations grounded in evidence play an essential role in the fight against climate change and other environmental threats. Good regulatory practices such as regulatory impact assessment (RIA), stakeholder consultation, *ex post* evaluation, international regulatory co-operation (IRC) and enforcement and inspections allow governments to embed environmental considerations at all stages of the regulatory cycle, ensuring policy coherence and promoting compliance for a climate-resilient and sustainable future.

This seminar provides an overview of the tools and methodologies developed by the OECD Regulatory Policy Committee to help countries design and implement such effective and efficient regulatory frameworks to guide green policy decisions and deliver on ambitious climate and environmental goals.
