

## VIII MEETING OF IBERO-AMERICAN AND CARIBBEAN REGULATORY IMPROVEMENT NETWORK

10 and 11 October, 2019

### Lima, Peru

The Ibero-American and Caribbean Regulatory Improvement Network seeks at establishing a permanent dialogue on the progress and challenges promoting regulatory quality in Ibero-American and Caribbean countries. The main objective of the Network is to communicate and exchange experiences and practices among experts in the region as well as OECD member countries.

As a reference, seven ordinary meetings have been held and one extraordinary in Buenos Aires, Argentina in March of this year, previous to the next VIII Meeting of the Ibero-American and Caribbean Network for Regulatory Improvement.
