

Main takeaways

- High-grade iron ores and DRI: importance to deepen our understanding of the global intricacies of HG iron ore supply chain.
- Scrap issues: the increasing relevance of steel scrap as a critical input signifies a transformative shift towards greener steel production and the need to maintain a frictionless market for scrap worldwide.
- Critical minerals for steel: discussed the importance of designing comprehensive critical mineral strategies that take the interest of the steel industry into account while promoting sustainability and resilience of supply chains.

What next?

- Bilateral discussions are underway to design specific in-depth case studies addressing the above issues.
