Hans Vijlbrief is the director general for economic policy at the Dutch Ministry of Economic Affairs in The Hague. As such he is responsible for macroeconomic policy, European affairs and competition policy. In this capacity he is also a member of the Central Economic Commission and vice-chairman of the Economic Policy Committee of the European Union. Since 2000 Prof. Vijlbrief also lectures economic policy at the Free University of Amsterdam. He formerly served as deputy director for the Netherlands Bureau for Economic Policy Analysis in The Hague.
