

Workshop with JIACC Liaison officers

Amman and Paris, 31 October 2023

Background

The OECD is undertaking the project “Ma’an – Together for an accountable and transparent public administration in Jordan” with the aim of improving public sector integrity and accountability in Jordan. One of the outputs of this project consists of an OECD Integrity Review of Jordan, which will provide a holistic assessment of the public sector integrity environment in Jordan and will elaborate practical policy recommendations for the Government of Jordan to strengthen coherence in the country’s integrity system. The Integrity Review follows the OECD Recommendation on Public Integrity (2017), which builds on three pillars: (i) building a coherent and comprehensive public integrity system; (ii) cultivating a culture of integrity; and (iii) enabling effective accountability.

Objective

The objective of this workshop is to bring together JIACC liaison officers to reflect on their experience working in the Jordanian public administration. The insights will directly feed into the OECD Integrity Review and help the OECD to provide meaningful and relevant recommendations to the JIACC and its role in preventing corruption and promoting integrity.
