Annette Widmann-Mauz studied political and legal science at Eberhard-Karls-Universität in Tübingen and worked, from 1993 to 1998, on a project of the European Commission at Tübingen University. Since 1998, she has been a member of the German Bundestag.

In 2003, Widmann-Mauz she was elected deputy chairwoman of the CDU Baden-Württemberg.

In her first legislative term, Widmann-Mauz joined the Committee on Health. Between 2005 and 2009, she served as her parliamentary group's spokesperson on health policy. In 2009, she became Parliamentary State Secretary at the Federal Ministry of Health.

Since 2018, Widmann-Mauz has been the Minister of State and Federal Government Commissioner for Migration, Refugees and Integration at the Federal Chancellery. Within her party, Widmann-Mauz is member of the Governing Board of the CDU Germany.
