He has also been Research Coordinator/Research Manager for two broad research programs on regional development at the Norwegian Research Council. Foss is acting as national ESPON Contact Point in Norway (continuously since 2002) and has been/is partner to several ESPON projects. He is also involved in territorial research outside Europe."
