"Supporting Green Transition through Circular Economy Roadmaps" project

In October 2022, the OECD South East Europe Regional Programme launched a new action to support competitiveness and sustainability in the Western Balkans and Türkiye, financed by the European Commission. This 4-year project aims to reinforce economic governance and integration, while strengthening resilient and competitive markets, in line with the EU enlargement strategy, the Economic and Investment Plan, and the Green and Digital Agendas for the Western Balkans. Under the third pillar of this action the OECD will support the "Green Transition through Circular Economy Roadmaps".

*This designation is without prejudice to positions on status, and is in line with United Nations Security Council Resolution 1244/99 and the Advisory Opinion of the International Court of Justice on Kosovo's declaration of independence.

Building on the *greening* work carried out as part of the OECD's flagship assessments of the Western Balkans, the <u>Competitiveness Outlook</u> and the <u>SME Policy Index</u>, as well as drawing upon the OECD's circular economy roadmap methodology, the OECD SEE Regional Programme will provide support towards the preparation and implementation of circular economy roadmaps.

For Albania, one of the two economies that has not yet developed a circular economy roadmap, the OECD is providing support for its design so that it serves as a blueprint for the circular economy transition and can be fed into circular economy strategies and/or complement various strategies and policies.

The OECD assistance also revolves around supporting implementation on certain themes within circular economy across the region, through provision of expertise, regional knowledge exchange and OECD and EU good practice transfers. This support is delivered in different formats, such as workshops, capacity building sessions, or other peer-learning exercises, that best fit the specific objective and optimise knowledge-sharing.

Objective

The objective of the meeting will be to present and discuss with the Circular Economy Working Group the state of play of circular economy in Albania, as a first step in the development of the circular economy roadmap.
