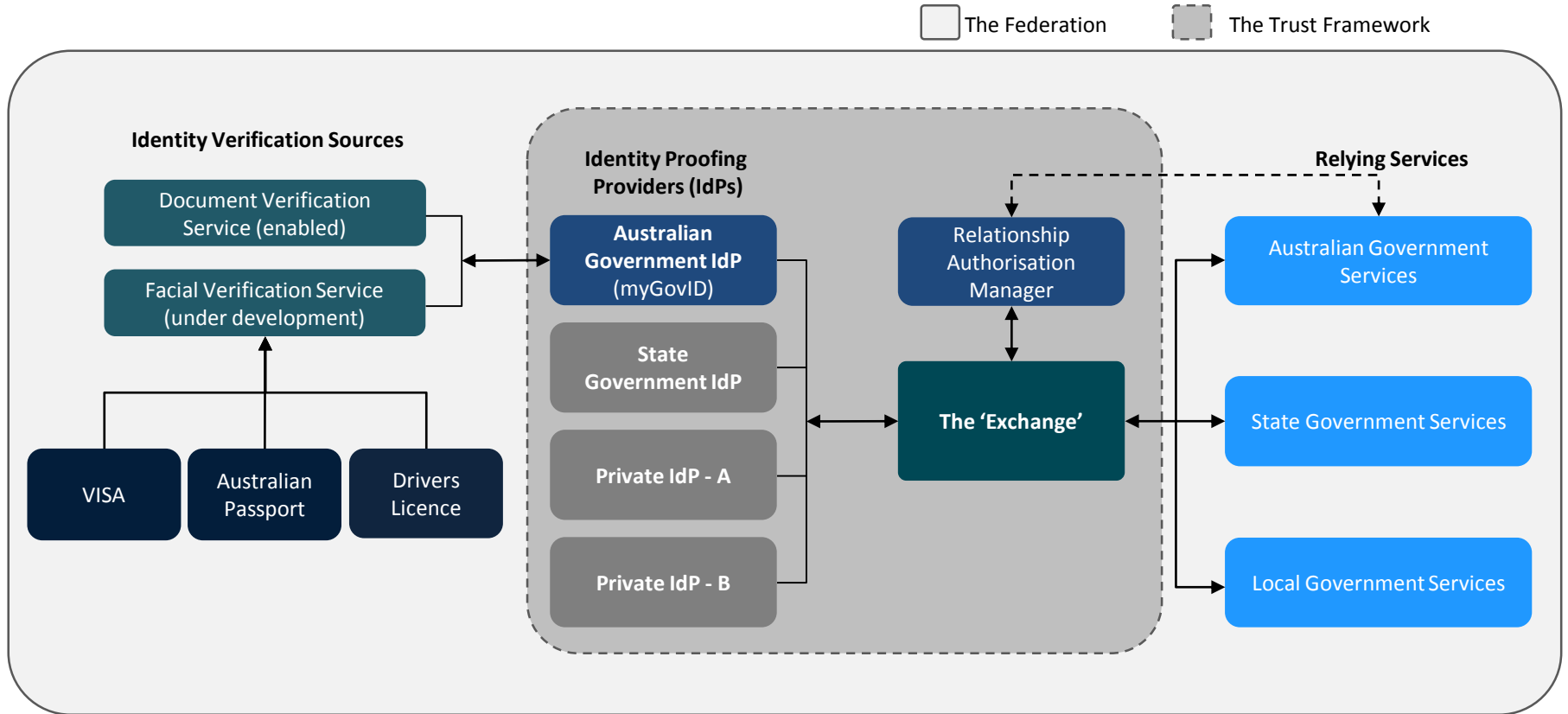

Australia's Federated Digital Identity Ecosystem

Australia's Digital Identity ecosystem is made up of a policy framework called the 'Trusted Digital Identity Framework' and a group of connected digital platforms designed around a federated identity model.



A user's identity attributes are verified against trusted identity documents using a Document Verification Service. This will be expanded to enable Facial Verification Services.



A group of trusted digital identity providers - provide identity verification services within the ecosystem, allowing users to choose their preferred provider

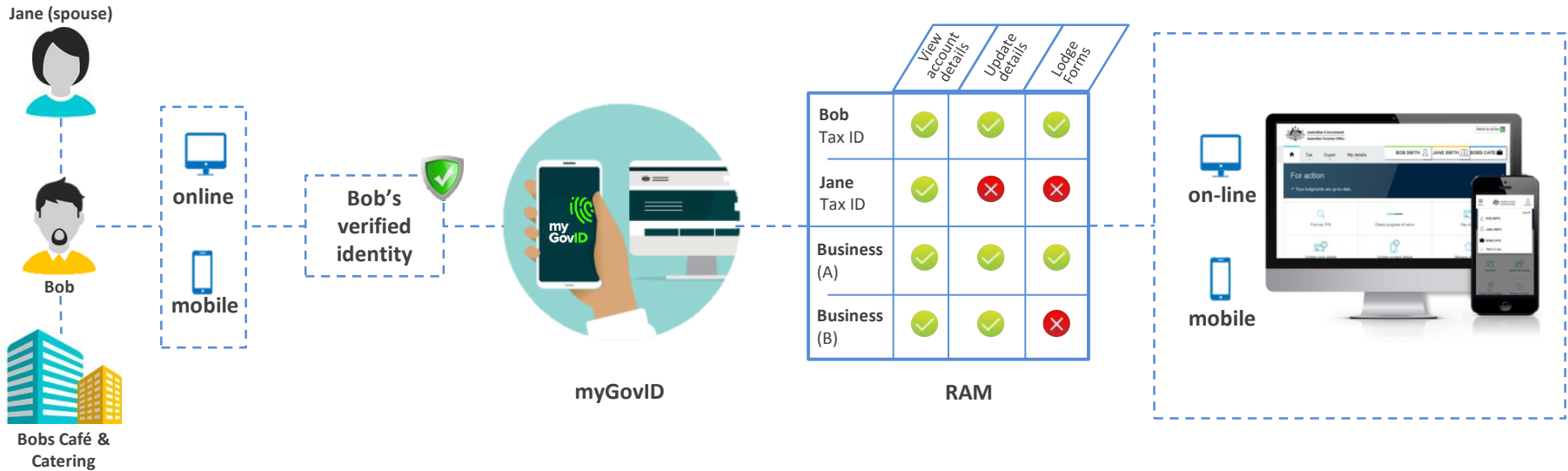


The Exchange acts as a double-blind gate or exchange of information, separating a relying service and the user's identity information



The Trust Framework sets out the policies and procedures for managing a consistent and coordinated whole-of-government digital identity ecosystem

How myGovID and RAM works



1 Bob establishes identity once & is enabled for ATO & other agencies

2 Bob can use his new portable Digital Identity to access a range of government services

3 An authorisation matrix determines what Bob can access and do. He can view/manage access to government online services in one place

4 Bob authenticates once to access all his authorised services through any channel
