

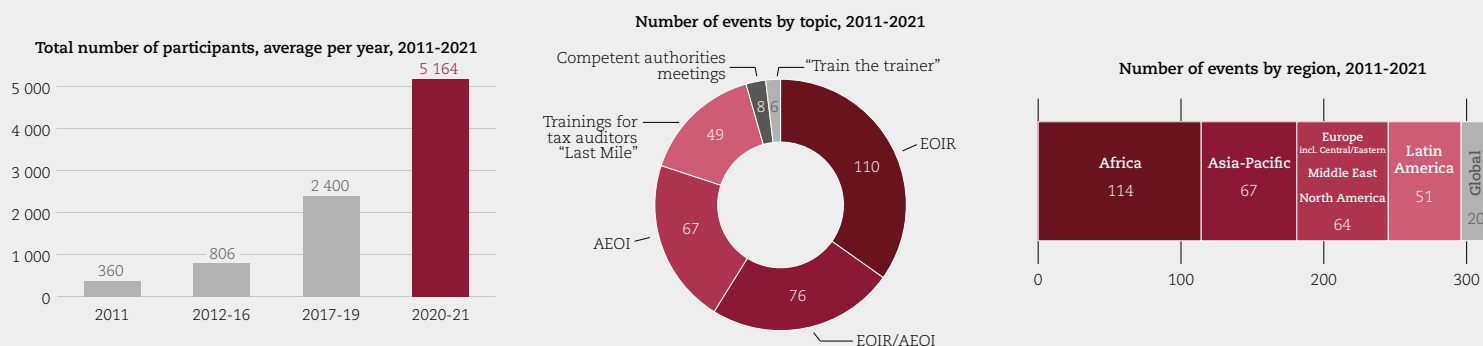
GLOBAL FORUM ON TRANSPARENCY AND EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION FOR TAX PURPOSES

Since **2011**, the Global Forum's capacity-building activities support the global implementation of the two international standards on transparency and exchange of information (EOI): exchange of information on request (EOIR) and automatic exchange of financial account information (AEOI). Our work empowers jurisdictions in the fight against tax evasion and other illicit financial flows to ultimately enhance their domestic resource mobilisation.

Since 2017, **more than half** of the Global Forum members are developing jurisdictions.

3 regional initiatives, focused on Africa, Latin America and the Pacific Islands, are advancing the transparency agenda worldwide since 2015, and a new initiative for Asia will start in 2022.

316 events have been organised since 2011 and **22 000 tax officials** have been trained:



75 jurisdictions received assistance from our Secretariat in 2021.

Various practical tools have been developed since 2011, including **6 new guidances** published in 2020-21, helping jurisdictions navigate key aspects of the effective EOIR and AEOI implementation:



10 years on, our work keeps delivering great results:

- ▶ **66** developing jurisdictions have joined the Convention on Mutual Administrative Assistance in Tax Matters since 2011, gaining access to a network of over 140 EOI partners, and 56 of them have it in force already.
- ▶ **45** of the 120 jurisdictions committed to implementing AEOI by a specific date are developing economies, and 32 of them have started automatic exchanges.
- ▶ **EUR 30 billion** of additional revenue has been identified by developing jurisdictions since 2009, through offshore tax investigations and voluntary disclosure programmes.
